This permit is granted under Section 33, Local Law No. 1 Neighbourhood Amenity 2012 and is subject to the following conditions:

1. the applicant indemnifies the Council from any loss, damage or personal and public injury resulting from the discharge of fireworks and/or other equipment used in the process to discharge fireworks.
2. appropriate plans have been put into place to attend to spot fires that may be caused by the fireworks.
3. the applicant has advised local CFA of proposed activity and obtain any permits required by the CFA.
4. the Worksafe 'Notification of intention to discharge fireworks' documentation has been provided and the person who supervisors and/or lights the fireworks has the relevant Worksafe licence and carries this on them at all times.
5. a site safety evaluation has been conducted PRIOR to setting up fireworks.
6. that notification is provided advising how local residents will be informed
7. the fireworks display will be conducted within the timeframe on the permit – should the event be postponed, an amendment to the permit will be required and a new permit issued.
